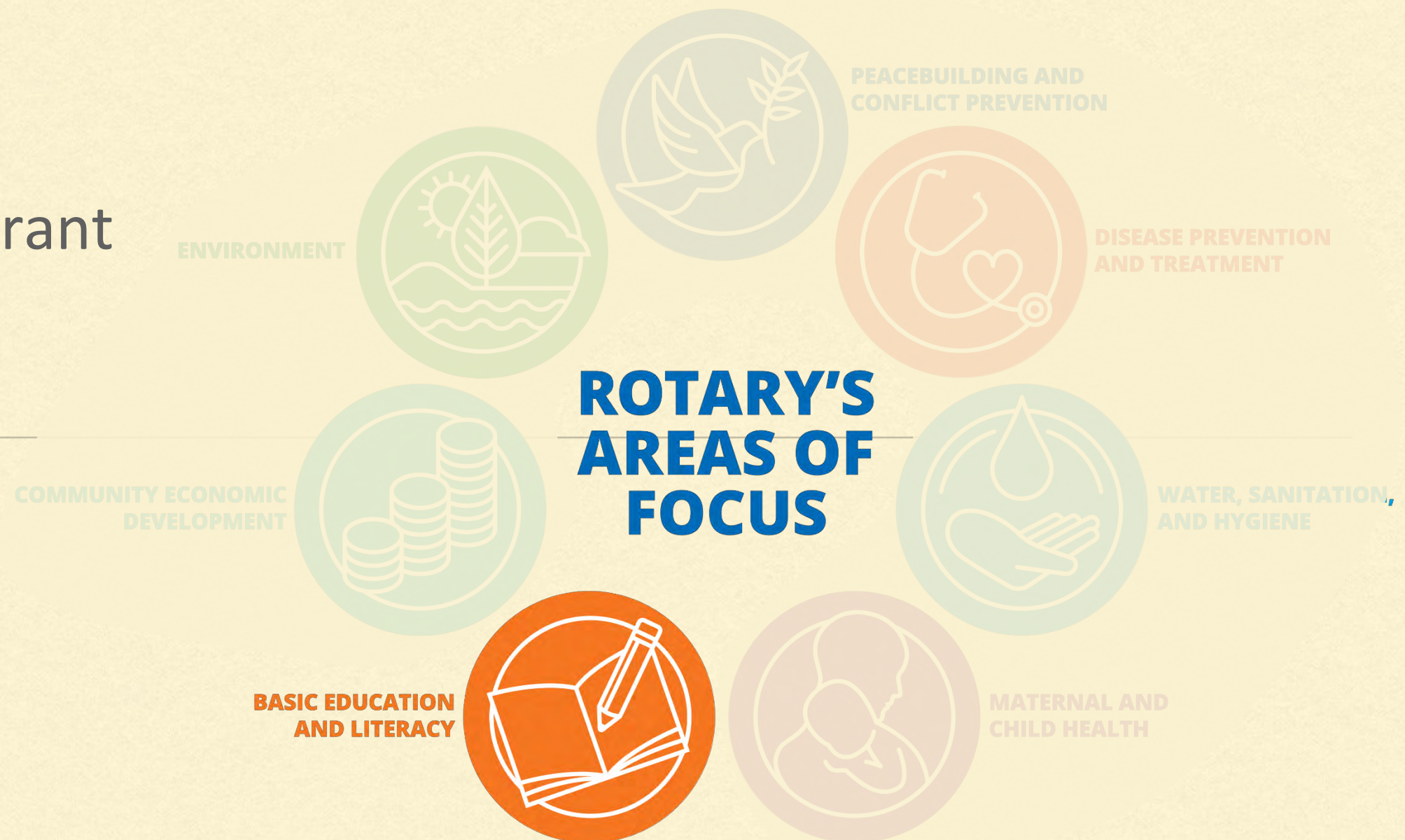

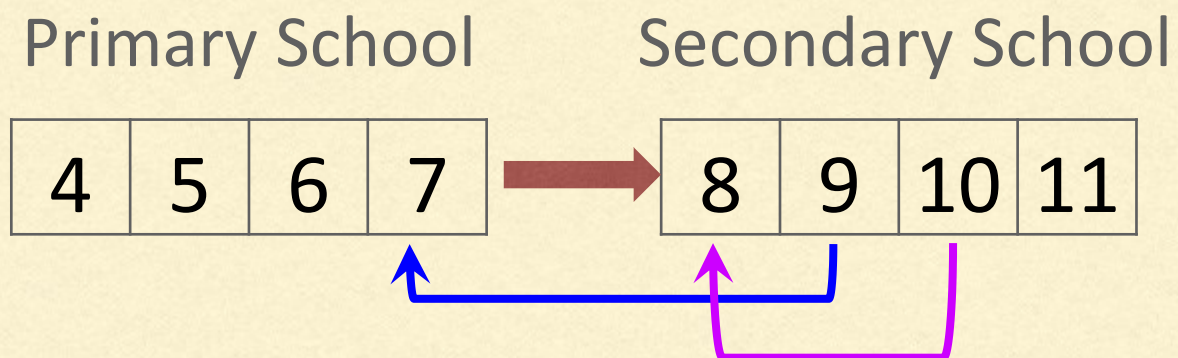


# Main objectives of the Global Grant
