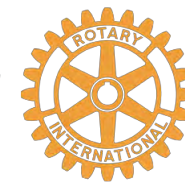

OUR SOLUTION

EMPOWER THE EDUCATOR

The purpose of the ECD Empowerment Training Initiative is to develop children age birth 7 years old in the Mathibestad area – north of Hammanskraal / Pretoria - targeting 20 ECD Centres in this rural community. This is to empower the educator.

- 40 candidates (learners),
- and impacting over 160 children

Learners / practitioners will receive a healthy meal each day of attendance, prepared by a local catering small business in the area.

43 days of training – various modules and curriculum
